## Gas Gauge - How to Make Your Own from a Paint Stirrer

Here are the measurements to make a paint stick gas gauge. Some owners have used Velcro and magnets glued to the stick to hold it on their tractors.

## Measurements:

Overall length 10 5/16 inches
From the bottom to top of each mark
$1 \mathrm{gal}=1$ 1/4"
$2 \mathrm{gal}=21 / 16^{\prime \prime}$
$3 \mathrm{gal}=23 / 4 "$
4 gal $=3$ 15/32"
$5 \mathrm{gal}=43 / 16^{\prime \prime}$
6 gal $=47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
$7 \mathrm{gal}=59 / 16^{\prime \prime}$
$8 \mathrm{gal}=61 / 4 "$
$9 \mathrm{gal}=73 / 16^{\prime \prime}$
10 gal = $81 / 16^{\prime \prime}$
